We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Village of Bloomington of its intent to deny portions of a Bloomington Police Department Domestic Battery Incident Report as exempt from disclosure under subsection 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act, as required by 5 ILCS 140/9.5(b).

As a result of this review, we have determined that it is appropriate for the Village of Bloomington to decline to disclose the redacted portions of this record under subsection 7(1)(c), because the information is personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of privacy. Thus, the Village of Bloomington's request to assert the exemption under 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c) is hereby **approved** and further inquiry into this matter is not warranted.
