RE: FOIA Pre-Approval Request – No. PAC 5392

Dear [REDACTED] and Tpr. Sutton:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Illinois State Police (ISP) of its intent to deny access to and redact information from the requested police report as exempt from disclosure under subsection 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 ILCS 140/9.5(b).

As a result of this review, we have determined that it is **appropriate** to withhold the following information or records under **Section 7(1)(c)** because disclosure of that information would likely be highly personal or objectionable to a reasonable person and the subject's right to privacy outweighs any public interest in releasing it: name of individual in residence upon execution of search warrant, dates of birth, and photographs of victim and injuries. Thus, the request to assert the exemption under **Section 7(1)(c)** is hereby approved and further inquiry into this matter is not warranted.

Please note that this determination is **only** intended to address the applicability of the **Section 7(1)(c)** exemption to the information the ISP seeks to redact and does not address the applicability of other exemptions to the information or records in question. It appears that some of the information the ISP seeks to redact may be properly exempt under sections other than 7(1)(c). Of note is Section 7(1)(d)(iv), which allows withholding of information that would reveal the identity of a confidential source. The ISP is not required to seek authorization from the Public Access Counselor prior to withholding information under exemptions other than 7(1)(c) and 7(1)(f).
