Dear Ms. Kavanaugh:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Schaumburg Police Department (Department) of its intent to partially deny disclosure of Arrest Report No. 94-1173 (Arrest Report) as exempt from disclosure under subsection 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*, as amended (FOIA). The Department has asserted that the release of approximately eight lines of narrative in a supplement to the Arrest Report would constitute an unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of the complainant.

The Department's use of the subsection 7(1)(c) exemption is approved with regard to the eight lines of narrative in the Arrest Report supplement. As such, the Department should issue a partial denial letter to [REDACTED] and release the Arrest Report to him with the appropriate information redacted.
