Dear Mr. [REDACTED] and Ms. Nistler:

The Office of the Public Access Counselor has received and reviewed the written notice from the Park Ridge Police Department (PRPD) of its intent to deny [REDACTED] request for a police report, in part, based on subsection 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/9.5(b) (FOIA). Based on subsection 7(1)(c), PRPD seeks to redact all dates of birth from the report.

As a result of this review, we have determined that it is **appropriate** for the PRPD to decline to disclose date of births pursuant subsection 7(1)(c). Depending on the circumstance, age can be a highly personal subject. Dates of birth, by their very nature, may be considered personal information, the disclosure of which could constitute an unwarranted invasion of privacy in accordance with subsection 7(1)(c). 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c).
