RE: Request for Pre-Authorization, 7(1)(c) – No. 2010 PAC 6001

Dear Trooper Sutton:

We have received and reviewed written notice from the Illinois State Police (ISP) of its intent to redact the witnesses's dates of birth and name of the blood-draw nurse from the records requested by [REDACTED] in a FOIA request dated February 4, 2010, as exempt from disclosure under subsection 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/9.5(b).

As a result of this review, we have determined that it is appropriate for the ISP to decline to disclose the redacted portions of this record under subsection 7(1)(c) because the information is personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of privacy. Thus, the ISP's request to assert the exemption under 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c) is hereby approved and further inquiry into this matter is not warranted.
