This correspondence will confirm that pursuant to our telephone conversation today, the Schaumburg Police Department (Department) is withdrawing its assertion that the police report in question is exempt from disclosure under subsection 7(1)(c) of FOIA. The Department has asserted that it intends to redact the victim's date of birth and release the remainder of the police report to [REDACTED]

As such, we have determined that no further inquiry is warranted with regard to this matter. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(b). The Department should issue a partial denial letter directly to [REDACTED]. This correspondence shall serve to close this matter.
