Dear Ms. Kavanaugh:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Village of Schaumburg Police Department (Department) of its intention to deny certain information as exempt from disclosure under subsection 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*, as amended. The Department is seeking to redact dates of birth of the security agents and complainants identified in a police report requested by Vivianne Velasquez dated 3/12/10.

The Department's use of the exemption in 7(1)(c) with regard to the dates of birth is approved. We have determined that the disclosure of dates of birth would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. This type of information is highly personal by its very nature and the subject's right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in disclosing this information. As such, the Department should issue a partial denial letter directly [REDACTED] and release the records to her with the appropriate information redacted, if you have not already done so.
