RE: FOIA Preauthorization Request – 2011 PAC 14875

Dear Mr. Jones:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Illinois Attorney General's Office of its intention to deny disclosure of certain information requested by pursuant to section 7(1)(f) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f) (West 2009 Supp.), as amended by Public Act 96-1378, effective July 29, 2010. Specifically, on May 17, 2011, and requested all records relating to consumer complaints and flooding issues at a linear in Barrington Hills, including records relating to some responsive documents to but it seeks to withhold some notes under section 7(1)(f).

Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA exempts from disclosure, "[p]reliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies or actions are formulated, except that a specific record or relevant portion of a record shall not be exempt when the record is publicly cited and identified by the head of the public body."

DETERMINATION

The Attorney General's Office's use of the exemption in section 7(1)(f) to withhold certain notes is **approved**. The records that the Attorney General's Office seeks preauthorization to withhold are notes in which policies and actions are formulated. These notes are predecisional materials that are covered by the section 7(1)(f) exemption. See Harwood v. McDonough, 344 Ill. App. 3d 242, 248 (1st Dist. 2003).
