

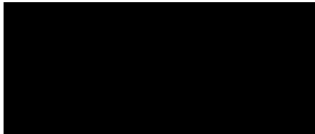

We have received from the Village of Oswego a notice of intention to deny disclosure of certain information under section 7(1)(k) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(k) (West 2010)) in connection with a June 21, 2011, FOIA request by . Please note that under section 9.5(b) of FOIA (5 ILCS 140/9.5(b) (West 2010)), advance approval by the Public Access Counselor is not required for the assertion of exemptions other than sections 7(1)(c) and 7(1)(f) (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c), (f) (West 2010)). Therefore, we make no determination at this time regarding the applicability of the section 7(1)(k) exemption.

Accordingly, the Village may issue a partial denial letter and release the records to  if it has not already done so.  may file a Request for Review with our office pursuant to section 9.5(a) of FOIA (5 ILCS 140/9.5(a) (West 2010)) if he wishes to dispute the applicability of the section 7(1)(k) exemption to the records in question.
