RE: FOIA Pre-approval Request – No. 6498

Dear Ms. Sujet:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Village of Lake in the Hills of its intent to deny access to and redact **dates of birth** from police reports, requested by [REDACTED] as exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/9.5(b).

As a result of this review, we have determined that it is **appropriate** to withhold **dates of birth** in the reports under **Section 7(1)(c)** because disclosure of that information would likely be highly personal or objectionable to a reasonable person and the subject's right to privacy outweighs any public interest in releasing it. Thus, the request to assert the exemption under **Section 7(1)(c)** is hereby approved and further inquiry into this matter is not warranted.


