Dear Ms. Curran:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Village of Lisle (Village) of its intent to deny disclosure of certain information as exempt from disclosure under subsection 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*, as amended (FOIA). The Village seeks to redact dates of birth on police reports numbered 09-8159 and 10-1557, requested by [REDACTED]

The Village's use of the exemption in 7(1)(c) with regard to the dates of birth is approved. We have determined that the disclosure of an individual's date of birth would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy under Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA, 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c). This type of information is highly personal, and the subject's right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in disclosing this information. The Village should issue a partial denial letter directly to [REDACTED] and release the records to [REDACTED] with the appropriate information redacted.
