Dear Mr. McDonald:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Glendale Heights Police Department (Department) of its intent to deny disclosure of certain information as exempt from disclosure under subsection 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*, as amended (FOIA). The Department seeks to redact a date of birth on police report number GL10004010.1, requested by [REDACTED]

The Department's use of the exemption in 7(1)(c) with regard to the date of birth is approved. We have determined that the disclosure of an individual's date of birth would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy under Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA. 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c). This type of information is highly personal, and the subject's right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in disclosing this information. The Department should issue a partial denial letter directly to [REDACTED] and release the records to [REDACTED] with the appropriate information redacted.
