RE: Pre-Authorization Request — 2010 PAC 7760

Dear Ms. Briggs:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Town of Normal (Town) of its intention to deny disclosure of certain information as exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*, as amended.

Shanna Gara, of Liberty Mutual, submitted a FOIA request dated May 24, 2010, seeking police report number 10-A557. In its written notice, the Town asserted that dates of birth and all matters reflecting the health of the driver(s) are exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA.

**Determination**

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA exempts from inspection and copying “[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, unless disclosure is consented to in writing by the individual subjects of the information.” 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c). The exemption defines “[u]nwarranted invasion of personal privacy” as “the disclosure of information that is highly personal or objectionable to a reasonable person and in which the subject’s right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining the information.” *Id.*

The Town’s use of the exemption in Section 7(1)(c) with regard to dates of birth is approved. We have determined that the disclosure of dates of birth would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy under Section 7(1)(c). 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c). This type of information is highly personal by its very nature and the subject’s right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in disclosing this information.

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The Town's use of the exemption in Section 7(1)(c) with regard to "all matters reflecting the health of the driver(s)" is denied. We have determined that the disclosure of this information would not constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy under Section 7(1)(c). 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c). We have determined that the Town has not met its burden to demonstrate a basis for redacting this information.

As such, the Town may issue a partial denial letter directly to the requester and release the records with the appropriate information redacted.
