RE: FOIA Preauthorization Request No. 2010 PAC 7840 (Technology Resource Services, Inc.)

Dear Mr. Hardy:

The Office of the Public Access Counselor has received and reviewed the documents provided in response to its June 16, 2010 further inquiry letter. That letter was sent after this office received written notice from the University of Illinois of its intention to deny in part the request for documents of Technology Resource Services, Inc. (TRS) pursuant to Section 7(1)(f) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f). Section 7(1)(f) exempts from disclosure "[p]reliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies and actions are formulated." 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f).

TRS had requested documents related to the evaluation and scoring of a bid proposal to perform certain services for the University. TRS had submitted one of the proposals for the project. The University proposed to provide the documents but to redact information that it asserts is protected under Section 7(1)(f).

After reviewing the documents, we have concluded that the proposed redactions are appropriate under Section 7(1)(f) because the redacted information consists of passages in which opinions are expressed about various prospective vendors. Accordingly, the University's request to redact the information pursuant to Section 7(1)(f) is approved.

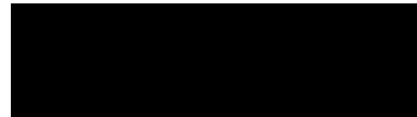
