RE: FOIA Pre-Approval Request – No. 8446

We have received and reviewed the written notice from Northfield Township High School District No. 225 of its intention to deny in part the request of Dan O'Brien of Illinois Central School Bus for copies of all detailed transportation invoices from May 2010 for regular education and special education students with certain stated exceptions. The District seeks approval of the Public Access Counselor to redact the name of a student pursuant to Section 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) because it constitutes "personal information, the disclosure of which would result in a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy." 5 ILCS 140/7(c). The District states that it has provided in full other information sought by the requestor.

As a result of this review, we have determined the information the District proposes to redact is exempt under Section 7(1)(c) because disclosure would result in a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Therefore, the request to assert the exemption under Section 7(1)(c) is approved and further inquiry into this matter is not warranted.


