RE: Pre-Authorization Request — 2010 PAC 8743

Dear Ms. Briggs:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Town of Normal (Town) of its intention to deny disclosure of certain information as exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*, as amended.

Kimberly Matteson submitted a FOIA request dated July 27, 2010, seeking a copy of file number A10-787, which relates to a traffic accident. In its written notice, the Town asserted that information which references specific injuries to a driver is exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA.

**Determination**

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA exempts from inspection and copying “[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, unless disclosure is consented to in writing by the individual subjects of the information.” 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c). The exemption defines “[u]nwarranted invasion of personal privacy” as “the disclosure of information that is highly personal or objectionable to a reasonable person and in which the subject’s right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining the information.” *Id.*

The Town's use of the exemption in Section 7(1)(c) with regard to driver's injuries is denied. The proposed redactions affect only general statements concerning a reported injury that may have occurred during this accident. The report discloses no detailed information regarding the precise nature of any medical condition, specific diagnoses or other sensitive matters. The Town has not met its burden of establishing that the disclosure of this information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy under Section 7(1)(c). 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c).

Accordingly, the Town must release the requested records to [REDACTED] in accordance with this letter.
