RE: FOIA Pre-Authorization Request – 2010 PAC 9590

Dear Mr. Reuter:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) of its intention to withhold certain information as exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). 5 ILCS 140/1 *et. seq.*, as amended.

Specifically, on August 24, 2010, Ms. Katie Larsen, on behalf of GeoScience Inc., submitted a FOIA request to the IEPA seeking copies of information relating to the National Castings and Meridian Rail facilities in Cicero.

On September 10, 2010, the IEPA submitted a pre-authorization request with this Office explaining that two November 22, 1993 documents relating to the National Castings facility are exempt from disclosure pursuant to Section 7(1)(f), which exempts from inspection and copying "preliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies are formulated, except that a specific record or relevant portion of a record shall not be exempt when the record is publicly cited and identified by the head of the public body." 5 ILCS 140 7(1)(f).

**Determinations**

The IEPA's request for approval of its decision to withhold information pursuant to Section 7(1)(f) is approved. This Office has reviewed the memoranda by the IEPA relating to the facility and we have determined that the documents are preliminary in nature and contain conclusions and recommendations about a possible course of action with respect to that site.

Additionally, there is no evidence that this information has been publicly cited and identified by the head of the public body. 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f).

Based on this analysis, the IEPA has met its burden under Section 7(1)(f) and may withhold the documents in question.
