Dear Mr. Reuter:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) of its intent to deny disclosure of certain information as exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f). IEPA's written notice relates to a FOIA request from Mr. Jason Carbone of the Emerson Park Development Corporation for records related to the Rockwood Pigments NA Inc. site. IEPA has asserted that three documents – a draft site inspection prioritization report, and two Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act pre-score scoresheets – are exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA.

Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA exempts from inspection and copying “[p]reliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda, and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies or actions are formulated”, as long as the document is not cited or publicly identified by the head of the public body. 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f).

Determinations

The IEPA's use of the exemption in Section 7(1)(f) is approved. The three documents in question reflect internal notes and recommendations that were intended to aid the IEPA in formulating final decisions on regulatory matters. Additionally, none of the documents has been publicly cited or identified by the head of the IEPA. Should you have questions or concerns, please call our office at 1-877-299-FOIA (3642).
