RE: Pre-Authorization Request – 2010 PAC 9032

Dear Mr. Reuter:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) of its intention to deny disclosure of certain information pursuant to Section 7(1)(f) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f).

On July 15, 2010, Mr. Sam Bodine submitted a FOIA request to IEPA seeking information regarding a specific facility located at [REDACTED] Algonquin, IL. In its written notice, IEPA asserts that certain documents contained within the requested records, specifically, a CERCLA preliminary assessment score-sheet and two memoranda, have been withheld from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA.

Determination

Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA exempts from inspection and copying “[p]reliminary” drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies or actions are formulated, except that a specific record or relevant portion of a record shall not be exempt when the record is publicly cited and identified by the head of the public body.” 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f).

The IEPA’s use of the Section 7(1)(f) exemption with regard to the withheld documents is **approved**. We have determined that the withheld documents are pre-decisional memoranda and recommendations that were relied upon by IEPA in its decision making process regarding a specific facility. Further, IEPA has indicated that none of these documents have been publicly cited by the Director of IEPA. Accordingly, IEPA has met its burden of establishing that the withheld documents are exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA.
