Dear Trooper Sutton,

We have reviewed your notice of intention to redact information from Illinois State Police Report No. C07-038061 pursuant to Section 7(1)(c) of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*, as amended. [REDACTED] requested records of his DNA test results in Cook County Case Nos. 08-CR-3590 and 08-CR-3591. The State Police asserted that the victim's name is exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(c).

Information in public records is exempt personal information if disclosure would "constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, unless the disclosure is consented to in writing by the individual subjects of the information." 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c). An "[u]nwarranted invasion of personal privacy" is the "disclosure of information that is highly personal or objectionable to a reasonable person and in which the subject's right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining the information." *Id.*

Determination


The request by the State Police to redact the victim's name pursuant to Section 7(1)(c) is *approved*. A crime victim's identity is highly personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. A crime victim's right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in the disclosure of his or her name.


