Dear Ms. Lloyd:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Aurora Housing Authority (AHA) of its intention to deny disclosure of a certain information contained in requested documents as exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*, as amended.

On February 24, 2011, [REDACTED] submitted a FOIA request to AHA for “[c]opies of any written or electronic communication between anyone from AHA (including board, staff and agents) and CG PARTNERS since September 1, 2010.” (Emphasis in original).

In its written notice, AHA asserts that e-mail discussions within the requested records are from the preliminary stage of the decision-making process and have been withheld from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA.

Determination

Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA exempts from inspection and copying “[p]reliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies or actions are formulated, except that a specific record or relevant portion of a record shall not be exempt when the record is publicly cited and identified by the head of the public body.”

AHA’s use of the Section 7(1)(f) exemption with regard to the withheld documents is **approved**. After review of the information provided, our office has determined that the withheld documents are records in which policies or actions were being formulated. Further, AHA has indicated that the documents have not been publicly cited by the head of the public body. Accordingly, AHA has met its initial burden of demonstrating that the withheld information is exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA.
