FOIA Pre-Authorization Request -2010 PAC 9780

Dear Ms. Alexander

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Illinois Gaming Board (IGB) of its intention to withhold certain information as exempt from disclosure pursuant to Section 7(1)(f) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). 5 ILCS 140(1) et seq., as amended.

On September 22, 2010, Robert Boyle on behalf of Shefsky and Froelich, submitted a FOIA request to the IGB seeking copies of records relating to Central Communications System award.

On September 22, 2010, IGB sent a pre-authorization request to this Office asserting that eight emails with regard to the award for the Central Communications System and the drafts for the pending Request for Proposal are exempt from disclosure pursuant to Section 7(1)(f) which exempts from inspection and copying preliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies are formulated, except that a specific record or relevant portion of a record shall not be exempt when the record is publicly cited and identified by the head of the public body." 5 ILCS 140 7(1)(f). On September 30, 2010, IGB provided us with a copy of a draft of the Request for Proposal and explained that the document had not been finalized and was subject to review.

Determinations

IGB's request for approval of its decision to withhold the information relating to the e-mails pursuant to Section 7(1)(f) is <u>approved</u>. The Section 7(1)(f) exemption is intended to encourage government officials to openly and frankly discuss matters of governmental concern in order to make informed policy decisions. See *N.L.R.B. v. Sears*, 421 U.S. 132 (1975), Hoffman v. Ill. Dept. of Corrections, 158 Ill.App.3d 473, 511 N.E.2d 759 (1st Dist. 1987).

This Office has reviewed the e-mails and determined that they contain preliminary findings by the IGB regarding the Request for Proposal. This Office has also reviewed the draft and finds that it is also preliminary in nature and falls within the scope of Section 7(1)(f).

Moreover, there is no evidence that this information was cited or identified by the head of the public body.

Therefore, it is our determination that IGB has met its burden under Section 7(1)(f) and may withhold the e-mails and draft of the Request for Proposal.
