RE: FOIA Preauthorization Request – 2011 PAC 13156

Dear Ms. Curran:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Village of Lisle of its intent to withhold portions of a report requested by [REDACTED] as exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c). Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA exempts from disclosure “[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.” That provision further defines an “unwarranted invasion of personal privacy” as “the disclosure of information that is highly personal or objectionable to a reasonable person and in which the subject’s right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining the information.”

[REDACTED] had requested a copy of a report about an incident that took place at a specified Lisle address on January 17, 2011. No criminal charges were filed with regard to that incident. The Village intends to provide a redacted version of the report to [REDACTED]. We have carefully reviewed the redacted and unredacted versions of the report in question and conclude that the withheld information is highly personal and disclosure would be objectionable to a reasonable person. Furthermore, the subject’s right to privacy outweighs any legitimate interest in obtaining the information that the Village proposes to withhold. Accordingly, the Village’s request to assert the Section 7(1)(c) exemption is approved.

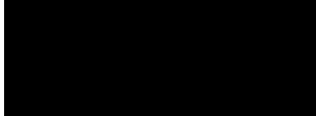
