Dear Ms. Moritz:

We have received written notice from the Village of Forest Rark (Village) of its intention to withhold certain information from disclosure pursuant to Section 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 5 ILCS 140/1 et-seq. as amended.

Specifically, on September 16, 2010 Mr. David Jackson, on behalf of the Chicago Tribune, submitted a FOIA request to the Village seeking a copy of Incident No. 08-08 03474. The report stems from an August 29 and August 30, 2008, matter at Riveredge Hospital in the Village. No arrests were made and this case is closed in its written request the Village has asserted that the entire report is exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(e), which exempts from inspection and copying "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, unless disclosure is consented to in writing by the individual subjects of the information." 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c). The exemption defines "[u]nwarranted invasion of personal privacy" as "the disclosure of information that is highly personal or objectionable to a reasonable person and in which the subject's right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining the information." *Id*.

Determination

The Village's request for approval of its decision to withhold the report in its entirety pursuant to Section 7(1)(c) is <u>approved</u>. This Office has reviewed the report and we have determined that the information contained therein is highly personal by its very nature, and that disclosure of this information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of privacy. Although there were allegations of possible criminal conduct, no arrest resulted from the investigation. Under these circumstances, the subjects' right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in disclosing this information.

Accordingly, the Village has met its initial burden of demonstrating that this information is exempt from disclosure in its entirety under Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA.
