Re: Pre-Authorization Request – 2010 PAC 10368

Dear Mr. Reuter:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) of its intention to deny disclosure of a certain document as exempt under Section 7(1)(f) of the Freedom of Information Act. 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*, as amended (FOIA).

Richard Forbes submitted a FOIA request on July 14, 2010 seeking records associated with the following public water supplies: IL1170400, IL1195150, IL1435030, IL1570150, IL1570250, IL1635040. In its written notice, the IEPA asserted that a certain document is exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f)) because it is "...preliminary in nature and not considered to be a final determination...and is subject to revision."

Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA exempts from disclosure records that constitute "[p]reliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies or actions are formulated, except that a specific record shall not be exempt when the record is publicly cited and identified by the head of the public body."

Determination

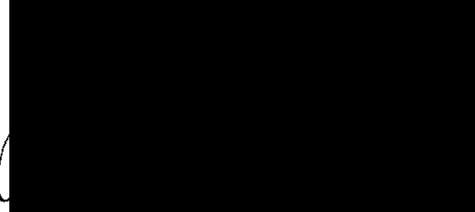
The IEPA's proposed application of the exemption found in Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA to deny disclosure of a specified document is approved. We have reviewed the document provided by the IEPA and have determined that it is a preliminary draft of a letter, which the IEPA asserted has not been publicly cited by its Director. Therefore, the IEPA has met its burden of demonstrating that the specific document is exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA.

Accordingly, the IEPA may issue a partial denial letter withholding the specified document.
