Dear Ms. Briggs:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Town of Normal (Town) of its intention to deny disclosure of certain information as exempt from disclosure under section 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*, as amended.

On October 25, 2010, the Town received a request from LexisNexis for a traffic crash report of incident # 1013, which occurred on September 23, 2010. In its written notice dated October 29, 2010, the Town asserted that the dates of birth included in the report are exempt from disclosure under subsection 7(1)(c) of FOIA.

Determination

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA exempts from inspection and copying “[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, unless disclosure is consented to in writing by the individual subjects of the information.” 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c). The exemption defines “[u]nwarranted invasion of personal privacy” as the “disclosure of information that is highly personal or objectionable to a reasonable person and in which the subject’s right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining the information.” *Id.*

The Town’s use of the exemption in section 7(1)(c) with regard to the dates of birth is approved. We have determined that the disclosure of dates of birth would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy under section 7(1)(c). 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c). This information is highly personal, and the subject’s right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in disclosing this information.

Accordingly, the Town should issue a partial denial letter directly to LexisNexis and release the report to LexisNexis with the appropriate information redacted.
