We have received the written notice from the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) of its intention to deny certain information as exempt from disclosure under section 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c) (West 2009 Supp.), as amended by Public Act 96-1378, effective July 29, 2010). Specifically, on April 28, 2011, Esther Seitz of the law firm Donald M. Craven, P.C., requested a copy of the Public Access Counselor's (PAC) determination in 2010 PAC 7531 (Ill. Att'y Gen. PAC Pre-Auth. dl 7531, issued September 8, 2010) and any subsequent opinions or correspondence issued by the PAC in connection with that matter. OAG is seeking to redact a minor's name under section 7(1)(c).

We have received confirmation that Ms. Seitz has waived any objection to OAG's proposed redaction of a minor's name under section 7(1)(c). Accordingly, the Public Access Counselor will not issue a determination in this matter. OAG may issue a partial denial letter and release the records with the minor's name redacted, if it has not already done so. If you have any questions, please contact me at (312) 814-6756.
