Re: Pre-authorization request – 2010 PAC 10728

Dear Ms. Nistler:

We have received the Park Ridge Police Department's (Department) notice of intention to deny disclosure of certain information requested under the Freedom of Information Act. 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*, as amended. [REDACTED] requested copies of Report No. 10-21710 and 10-21759. The Department asserted that the birth dates of the complainant and others listed in the report are exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(c) (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c)).

Information in public records is exempt if disclosure would "constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, unless the disclosure is consented to in writing by the individual subjects of the information." 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c). An "[u]nwarranted invasion of personal privacy" is the "disclosure of information that is highly personal or objectionable to a reasonable person and in which the subject's right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining the information." *Id.*

Determination

The Department's request for pre-approval to redact birth dates pursuant to Section 7(1)(c) is **approved**. Birth dates are a highly personal form of information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. A subject's right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in the disclosure of his or her date of birth.

The Department intends to redact additional information pursuant to Section 7(1)(b) (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(b)), Section 7(1)(d)(i) (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(d)(i)), and Section 7(1)(d)(iv) (5 ILCS

140/7(1)(d)(iv)). We have not analyzed the assertion of those exemptions; the assertion of those exemptions by the Department is not contingent upon receiving pre-approval from our office.

This letter amends our original determination, dated November 17, which only referenced one of the two reports (10-21710) for which the Department requested pre-approval to redact birth dates. This letter clarifies that the Department may redact birth dates from Report Nos. 10-21710 and 10-21759 pursuant to Section 7(1)(c).
