ection 7(1)(f) of FOIA (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f)) which exempts from inspection and copying

Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f)), which exempts from inspection and copying "preliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies are formulated, except that a specific record or relevant portion of a record shall not be exempt when the record is publicly cited and identified by the head of the public body."

Determinations

SIU's request for approval of its decision to withhold the letter pursuant to Section 7(1)(f) is approved.

The Section 7(1)(f) exemption is intended to encourage government officials to openly and frankly discuss matters of governmental concern in order to make informed policy decisions. See *N.L.R.B. v. Sears*, 421 U.S. 132 (1975), Hoffman v. Ill. Dept. of Corrections, 158 Ill.App.3d 473, 511 N.E.2d 759 (1st Dist. 1987). Our Office has reviewed the letter and we have concluded

that the document reflect the opinions and recommendations of SIU and accordingly falls within the scope of Section 7(1)(f).

Additionally, there is no evidence that this information has been publicly cited and identified by the head of the public body. 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f).

Based on this analysis, SIU has met its initial burden under Section 7(1)(f) and may withhold the document in question.
