Dear Trooper Sutton:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Illinois State Police (ISP) of its intention to deny disclosure of certain information as exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*

Specifically, on November 23, 2010, [REDACTED] submitted a FOIA request to ISP, seeking a copy of the DNA laboratory report pertaining to his case. In its written notice, ISP asserts that the identity of the victim, contained within the report, is exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA. 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c).

Determination

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA exempts from inspection and copying "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy." The exemption defines "unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" as "the disclosure of information that is highly personal or objectionable to a reasonable person and in which the subject's right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining the information." *Id.*

ISP's use of the Section 7(1)(c) exemption with regards to the identity of the victim is **approved**. We have determined that release of this information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. This type of information is highly personal by its very nature and its release would be objectionable to a reasonable person. Hence, ISP has met its initial burden of demonstrating that this information is exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA.
