Dear Mr. Jasculca:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from Oak Park Elementary School District 97 (District) of its intention to deny disclosure of certain documents as exempt under Section 7(1)(f) of the Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*, as amended (FOIA).

██████████ submitted a FOIA request to the District on November 8, 2010 seeking the following information:

1. A copy of all policy statements, internal memos, e-mail messages and other documents concerning District 97's collection, maintenance and destruction of school student records under the Illinois School Students Records Act (ISSRA) (105 ILCS 10/1 *et seq.*).
2. A copy of all policy statements, internal memos, e-mail messages and other documents concerning District 97 teacher's providing student educational information and course recommendations to high schools of graduating students.
3. A copy of all policy statements, internal memos, e-mail messages and other documents, regarding changes or recommended changes in the internal policies and procedures with regard to District 97's collection, maintenance and destruction of school student records under ISSRA, in light of the recent appellate court ruling in *Garlick v. Oak Park and River Forest High School District #200*, 389 Ill. App. 3d 306.
4. A copy of all policy statements, internal memos, e-mail messages and other documents, expressing commentary of the effects of these policy changes.
