Dear Ms. Holmes:

We have received and reviewed a partial notice of intention to deny issued by the Macomb Police Department (Department) in response to request for records under the Freedom of Information Act. 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq., as amended. regarding The Department requested pre-approval to withhold a statement made by In Report No. 2006-17441.

Information in public records is exempt personal information if disclosure would "constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, unless the disclosure is consented to in writing by the individual subjects of the information." 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c). An "[u]nwarranted invasion of personal privacy" is the "disclosure of information that is highly personal or objectionable to a reasonable person and in which the subject's right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining the information." *Id*.

The Department's request to withhold statement statement pursuant to Section 7(1)(c) is approved. We have reviewed a copy of the statement, which contains information that is highly personal by its very nature. A subject's right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in the disclosure of this type of information.

The Department intends to withhold additional information pursuant to Section 7(1)(b) (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(b)). We have not analyzed the assertion of that exemption; the assertion of that exemption by the Department is not contingent upon receiving pre-approval from our office.
