Dear Mr. Reuter:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) of its intention to deny disclosure of certain information pursuant to Section 7(1)(f) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*, as amended.

On November 18, 2010, [REDACTED] submitted a FOIA request to IEPA LUST Technical, LUST Fiscal, SRP Technical, SRP Fiscal, FOS, Compliance, Permits, and Ground Water records pertaining to 4900 Willow Springs Road in Western Springs.

In its written notice, the IEPA asserts that two documents contained within the requested records are pre-decisional and have been withheld from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA.

Determination

Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA exempts from inspection and copying “[p]reliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies formulated, except that a specific record or relevant portion of a record shall not be exempt when the record is publicly cited and identified by the head of the public body.”

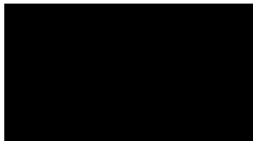
The IEPA’s use of the Section 7(1)(f) exemption with regard to the withheld documents is **approved**. After review, our office has determined that the withheld documents are pre-decisional documents. Further, the IEPA has indicated that these documents have not been publicly cited by the Director of the IEPA. Accordingly, the IEPA has met its initial burden of demonstrating that the withheld documents are exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA.

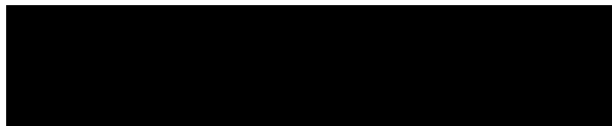
