Dear Mr. Reuter:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) of its intention to deny disclosure of certain information as exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f). Ms. Patti Blazer has requested records relating to Joslyn Corporation. IEPA asserts that certain of the responsive records are exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA.

Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA exempts from inspection and copying “[p]reliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies or actions formulated, except that a specific record or relevant portion of a record shall not be exempt when the record is publicly cited and identified by the head of the public body.” 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f).

Determination


We have determined that IEPA’s use of the exemption in Section 7(1)(f) with regard to these documents is approved. These documents are pre-decisional in nature, they contain recommendations, and they were used to formulate actions. The IEPA asserts that these documents have not been publicly cited or identified by the Director of the IEPA. Thus, the IEPA has met its initial burden of showing that these documents are exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f).
