Dear Trooper. Sutton:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Illinois State Police (ISP) of its intention to deny disclosure of suspect and victims' names from reports in case 08CR-17931 as exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c).

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA exempts from inspection and copying "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, unless disclosure is consented to in writing by the individual subjects of the information." 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c). The exemption defines "[u]nwarranted invasion of personal privacy" as "the disclosure of information that is highly personal or objectionable to a reasonable person and in which the subject's right of privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining the information." *Id.*


**Determination**

ISP's use of the exemption in Section 7(1)(c) with regard to withholding suspect and victim names is **approved**. This information is highly personal, and the subjects' right to privacy with respect to this information outweighs any legitimate public interest in its disclosure. As such, disclosure of the information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy under Section 7(1)(c).
