Dear Mr. Reuter:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) of its intention to deny disclosure of certain information pursuant to Section 7(1)(f) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq., as amended.

On January 19, 2011, Ms. Alison Hayden of Hodge Dwyer & Driver, Attorneys at Law submitted a FOIA request to IEPA for LUST Technical, SRP Technical, Permit Application, Compliance VN, and Ground Water records pertaining to the Caterpillar Inc. Plant in Mapleton.

In its written notice, the IEPA asserts that four (4) documents contained within the requested records are pre-decisional and have been withheld from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA.

Determination

Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA exempts from inspection and copying "[p]reliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies formulated, except that a specific record or relevant portion of a record shall not be exempt when the record is publicly cited and identified by the head of the public body."

The IEPA's use of the Section 7(1)(f) exemption with regard to the withheld document is **approved**. After review, our office has determined that the withheld documents are pre-decisional, are ones in which polices or actions were formulated, and contain recommendations. Further, the IEPA has indicated that these documents have not been publicly cited by the Director of the IEPA. Accordingly, the IEPA has met its initial burden of demonstrating that the withheld documents are exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of FOIA.
