On January 24, 2011 written notice to the Office of the Public Access Counselor County asserted that dates of birth are exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c)) which exempts from inspection and copying, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, unless disclosure is consented to in writing by the individual subjects of the information." The exemption defines "[u]nwarranted invasion of personal privacy" as "the disclosure of information that is highly personal of objectionable to large asonable personal in which the subject's right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining the information.

Determination

The County's use of the exemption in Section 7(1)(c) with regard to a date of birth is <u>approved</u>. This type of information is highly personal by its very nature and the subject's right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in disclosing this information. As such, County may issue a partial denial letter directly to the requestor and release the records with the appropriate information redacted if it has not already done so.
