Dear Ms. Clark:

We have received and reviewed the written notice from the Village of Downers Grove of its intention to deny certain information as exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*, as amended (FOIA).

██████████ submitted a FOIA request for police reports regarding the HUB Group within the last 10 years. In its written notice, the Department asserted that certain information in the narrative portion of the report regarding a domestic situation is exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA exempts from inspection and copying “[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, unless disclosure is consented to in writing by the individual subjects of the information.” 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c). The exemption defines “[u]nwarranted invasion of personal privacy” as “the disclosure of information that is highly personal or objectionable to a reasonable person and in which the subject’s right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining the information.” *Id.*

Determination

The Department proposes to redact portions of the narrative of the report #01-08-010082. The Department’s use of the exemption in Section 7(1)(c) with regard to this portion of the narrative is approved. We have determined that the disclosure of this information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy under Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA. Those statements in the narrative contain information regarding a domestic situation, the disclosure of which would be objectionable to a reasonable person. The subject’s right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining this information.

Accordingly, the Department may issue a partial denial letter and release the report with the appropriate information redacted, if it has not already done so.

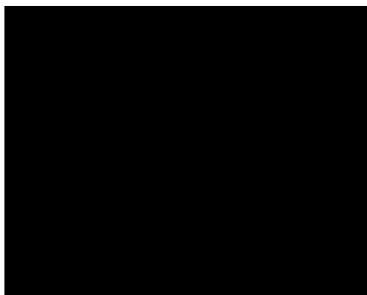
