Dear Mr. Rent:

We have received and reviewed the notice from the City of Urbana of its intention to deny disclosure of certain information under Section 7(1)(c) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c).

On February 23, 2011, the City received a FOIA request from [REDACTED] for "Any and all reports. U10-807." The City asserts that the responsive report is exempt from disclosure in its entirety under Section 7(1)(c).

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA exempts from inspection and copying "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, unless the disclosure is consented to in writing by the individual subjects of the information." 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c). The exemption defines "[u]nwarranted invasion of personal privacy" as "the disclosure of information that is highly personal or objectionable to a reasonable person and in which the subject's right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining the information." *Id.*

**Determination**

The City's use of the exemption in Section 7(1)(c) to withhold this report is approved. This report pertains entirely to a highly personal matter, and the subjects' right to privacy outweighs any legitimate public interest in obtaining this information. Therefore, we find that the City has sustained its initial burden of demonstrating that this report is exempt under Section 7(1)(c).

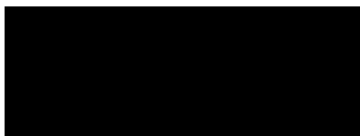
